**Call to Order**

**Approval of Minutes of November 2, 2010 Meeting**

Perhaps have the front row sell for \$10, 2<sup>nd</sup> row for \$7.50, 3<sup>rd</sup> row for \$5. All were in agreement that this was a good idea. We'll set up an online 'reservation' form for people to sign up and Dr. Boudreau will ascertain the number of seats in each row. Jill suggested that we collect Food Pantry donations at the Winter Concert as well.

The Student Spirit and Service Club is putting on Pajama Day on 12/17. Santa will visit the classrooms bearing gifts on the 16<sup>th</sup>.

**President's announcements**

We need to do something about the hill in the playground space, as we have been unable to keep grass alive in that area. The wear and tear in that area makes any shade grass ineffective. Artificial grass would be very expensive, but we could put down wood chips and potentially some other playground equipment. Put committee on agenda for January with hope of putting something together in March.

The Gingerbread House event was really successful and everyone had a good time. We sold 61 houses, though we had hoped to sell 80. It is felt that word of mouth will make this a bigger event next year. The event cost the PTC about \$100, but it was not meant to be a fundraiser. If we had sold 5 more houses, we would have broke even.

We have a Flying High event scheduled for December 20.

We have someone interested in the VP Communications position. Mary will work to bring her on board.
